

## **Yamaha MOTIF-RACK XS Editor VST V1.4.0 for Macintosh Release Notes**

### **Main Revisions and Enhancements**

V1.3.0 to V1.4.0

#### **<New Features>**

- Now supports Cubase 5.5 series.

#### **<Fixed Bugs>**

- Solved a problem in which the save operation might fail when you select "Save As..." after selecting "New" from the File menu.
- Solved a problem in which Cubase is forced to quit when you close the Editor window during the Import operation when in the ONLINE status.
- Solved a problem in which Cubase might be forced to quit occasionally when MIDI data is played back with the Editor window open.
- Solved a problem in which the VSTi settings of the Editor might not be restored when opening a Project file of Cubase.
- Solved a problem in which right-clicking would not call up the menu after right-clicking on the starting up window of the Editor.
- Solved a problem in which the entire volume might be lowered to 0 when changing the mode from the Editor.
- Minor bug fixes.

### **Known Issues**

- After re-installation of the Editor, the Voice name may occasionally not appear on the Media Bay windows of Cubase. If this is the case, execute "Refresh" or "Rescan".
- No sound may be produced when you use Editor for the Instrument track and change the Voice of the track to one of the HALionOne via the Track Preset button. If this is the case, set the VST Instrument of the track to "without Instrument" then select the Voice of the HALionOne, or select the Voice of a VST Instrument other than the HALionOne, then select the HALionOne's Voice via the Track Preset button.
- The Editor may launch in the OFFLINE status or "Port Open Error" may appear when you: 1) select the MOTIF-RACK XS Voice via the Media Bay, 2) create the Instrument Track on Cubase, and 3) start the Editor. Even if such a situation occurs, you can use the Editor by clicking the ONLINE/OFFLINE switch to set the status to ONLINE.

### <New Features>

- Now supports Mac OS X 10.6 Snow Leopard.
- Now supports Cubase 5.1.
- Now supports Yamaha Steinberg FW Driver V1.5.0.
- Reduced the launching time of the Editor.
- Made it possible to overwrite a current project of the DAW by holding down the <Ctrl> key and pressing the <S> key on the Editor.
- The Editor now will start up in the Voice mode regardless of the Startup Mode parameter of the Editor Setup when you launch the Editor from an Instrument Track or the MediaBay of Cubase. However, the Editor will start up in the same mode as the currently selected mode of the instrument by the "Current" settings of the "Auto Sync Setting" in the Editor Setup when Auto Start setting of the Editor Setup is set to "ON".

### <Fixed Bugs>

- Solved a problem in which a sound would sustain while using the Virtual Keyboard of Cubase.
- Solved a problem in which the Editor would not communicate with the instrument properly when connecting your computer to the instrument using a USB cable, even though the MIDI settings of the Editor Setup were correct.
- Solved a problem in which Cubase would occasionally quit unexpectedly when you change a MOTIF-RACK XS Voices were changed frequently in the MediaBay window of Cubase.
- Minor bug fixes.
